## What is EVA?

The Finnish Business and Policy Forum EVA (known by its Finnish acronym EVA) is a private think tank founded in 1974 and funded by key business organisations in Finland. It is independent of government and political parties. EVA's mission is to promote discussion about key national and international issues. EVA is a discussion forum and networking arena for decision-makers both in business and society. EVA publishes reports, organises debates and publishes policy proposals. EVA works in close co-operation with the Research Institute of the Finnish Economy ETLA - the two organisations share the same Board and Managing Director.

## EVA in action

EVA's task is to identify and evaluate trends that are important for Finnish companies and the society as a whole. Violent and rapid international phenomena impose serious demands on society and business activity. EVA aims to provide current information on prevailing trends and to bring fresh ideas to public debate. EVA influences and creates discussion in the society by publishing articles, reports, policy papers; by holding debates called EVA FORUMS; by organising seminars and by maintaining a EVA Fellows network which consists of EVA Fellows, Parliamentary Fellows, Junior Fellows and the international counterpart organisations.
